

## FOODS TOXIC TO PETS

Here is a quick reference guide to the more common house and garden plants and foods (and other substances) that are toxic to most all animals. If you have these plants or foods, you need not dispose of them--just keep them away from your pets. Although it is impossible to list all possible poisons, these guidelines may help you begin to remove or place out of reach most potential problems. This list is NOT ALL INCLUSIVE and may not include items poisonous to Hamsters/Guinea Pigs/Iguanas/etc

**\* INDICATES THAT A SUBSTANCE IS ESPECIALLY DANGEROUS AND CAN BE FATAL.**

### **Foods which are toxic and poisonous to pets:**

Alcohol (all forms)	Mouldy/spoiled foods
Almonds*	Mushrooms (wild mushrooms grown in yard or woods)
Apples seeds (contains cyanide)	Nutmeg
Apricots*	Onions*
Avocado (leaves, seeds, stem, skin)*	Peaches* (stem, leaves, pits)
Broccoli (in large amounts)	Pear seeds
Cherry pits (contains cyanide)	Plum seed/pit
Chocolate (all types)*	Potato (leaves, stem, peeling, and unripe)
Coffee grounds, beans & tea (caffeine)	Raisins
Figs	Rhubarb leaves*
Garlic*	Sugar Free items with Xylitol*
Grapes	Tomatoes (leaves, stem, and unripe)
Hops (used in home brewing)	Walnut hulls
Macadamia Nuts	Yeast dough
