English Ivy (All Hedera species of ivy)	Rhododendron
Fig (Ficus)	Rosary Pea (Arbus p•)*
Four-o'clocks (Mirabilis)	Rosary Pea, (Jequirity Bean)*
Foxglove (Digitalis)*	Schefflera (umbrella plant)*
